NOTICE OF HEARING OF COMPLAINT

TAKE NOTICE THAT a complaint has been filed against Marie-Anne LeVasseur and a copy of the complaint was previously provided to you.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE THAT evidence provided in connection with a complaint matter is of a confidential nature. It is in the best interest of the Complainant and Defendant to exercise discretion with respect to revealing or disclosing such evidence to other parties.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE THAT the Discipline Committee will conduct a hearing of the complaint via Zoom,

on Sunday, April 12, 2026,

commencing at *1:30 pm* (local time, EDT) or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard.

Any request by a party to a complaint to postpone a hearing shall reach the Head Office of the CKC at least five (5) days prior to the date fixed for the hearing.

If you have any objection regarding the composition of the panel, including any concerns regarding potential conflicts of interest, you must submit a written objection detailing the nature of your concerns to the Head Office of the CKC at least five (5) days prior to the date fixed for the hearing.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE THAT the complainant and defendant shall have the right to be heard in person, may at their expense produce such evidence and witnesses as they desire, and may at their expense be accompanied by or represented by person(s) of their choice when appearing before the Discipline Committee. Hearings are open to the public and any member of the CKC may observe the proceedings via the virtual gallery.

In accordance with Section 15.1 (g) of the By-laws any written evidence submitted to our office must be filed in such a manner that delivery can be validated (*regular mail is not acceptable*). If the defendant does not appear in person or provides written evidence, the Discipline Committee will proceed on the basis of the evidence on file. If you wish to make a written submission, complainants must file a summary of all evidence, and a list of all proposed witnesses (if applicable) to the attention of the Chair of the Discipline Committee, care of the Head Office, at least three (3) weeks (*March 22, 2026*) before the hearing. Defendants must do the same at least one (1) week (*April 5, 2026*) before the hearing.

You are asked to advise the writer by March 19, 2026, if you plan to participate in the Discipline Committee hearing for this file via Zoom and we will provide you with the link to the Zoom meeting. Please note that if you are participating, we have allotted ½ hour for this matter.


